**Tax forms have new changes**  
 SALT LAKE CITY — Utah taxpayers will receive several changes in the new tax forms, including the new standard deduction. Taxpayers will also have to provide more information on their federal returns to the state return. Utahns will also have the opportunity to make a charitable contribution to the state to assist the homeless. The Utah Tax Commission has the following reminders to Utah taxpayers:  
 1. File early. If you have a refund coming, the earlier you file the earlier you will receive your money. In 1989, the Tax Commission processed 400,000 individual income tax forms approximately half of those were filed the week of April 15.  
 2. Use the envelope and mailing label supplied with the form. The envelope is provided to be assessed by machine and one who is opened and sorted mechanically. If you have a refund coming, mark the designation on the back of the envelope. These returns are processed first.  
 3. Remember to calculate the use tax on the out-of-state purchases. If you purchased any taxable items or services on which sales tax was lower than the state tax rate for your locality, you are liable for use tax on the purchase price. This is chargeable purchase from out-of-state vendors. Instructions on how to calculate the use tax are found in the tax book.  
 4. Double check your return to avoid the most common errors: incorrect tax calculated from the tax rate schedule, incorrect itemized deductions transferred from the federal return, and math errors.  
 5. Remember to sign your return. If filing jointly, the spouse's signature is also required. The lack of required signatures will delay your refund.

**More non-whites in mortal danger**  
 WASHINGTON — Non-white males are nearly five times more likely to become murder victims in the overall United States population, according to recently released FBI data.  
 "Based on 1987 Uniform Crime Reporting data, Americans have a 1 in 177 chance of being murdered. If you happen to be non-white and male, those chances drop to 1 in 37. White females are the least likely to become murder victims during the course of their lifetime, with odds at 1 in 427.  
 "Violence against a murder victim is relatively stable until the age of 40, where the rate of victimization begins to decline. The risk of being a murder victim, according to the statistics. By the age of 40, the overall homicide rate is 1 in 1,000. The probability continues to decline with age."
