## Whitman celebration in N.Y. to honor democracy's poet

NEW YORK (AP) — Stop these days and nights with him, and you shall possess the origins of all poems. Specifically, from March 26, the centenary of Walt Whitman's death, to May 31, the 173rd anniversary of his birth.

During this period, a 10-week festival, "Democracy's Poet: A Walt Whitman Celebration," will take place in many of the Manhattan, Brooklyn and Long Island locations Whitman frequented and the streets he liked to say were his university.

The festival will open with song from the choir at the Cathedral of St. John the Divine. Later, Claire Bloom and Christopher Reeve will be among readers at a 12-hour marathon taping of his poetry.

Another marathon reading is planned for Whitman's Long Island birthplace, a conference at the Museum of the City of New York, and a symposium at the South Street Seaport Museum.

Varied events will reflect Whitman's varied roles in life — as editor, reporter, typesetter, writer, schoolteacher, road estate developer, clerk, nurse and doctor.

In all there will be a total of 10 readings, three exhibitions, two concerts, six symposium-panel discussions, three living history performances, 15 lectures and gallery talks, five walking tours and four family workshops.

The celebration is a collaborative event organized by the Museum of the City of New York in conjunction with 10 other organizations.
