The 1992 Family Invitational Art Exhibit and Sale, featuring paintings, photographs and ceramics by faculty members in the Creative Studies Division, will be Tuesday at 7 p.m. at the University of Utah's Fine Arts Center on the campus of Utah College in St. George.

The month-long juried exhibit, which features the work of more than 80 Utah artists, will be on display Monday through Saturday from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. and Sunday from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. through March 14.

Paints from the exhibit and sale will be applied toward the eventual construction of an art museum on the Utah campus.

Three theatricals will be featured in a two-day show this week at the Sugarloaf Center, 314 Main, Park City.

Advanced seating includes Edward Fraughton and painter Randall Lake and Bruce Cheever will be present at a reception in Park City from 6 to 11 p.m. They will discuss their work, technique and philosophy of art, and gallery director David Lee will show costumes Saturday from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m.

Mr. Fraughton has won the gold medal for sculpture from the National Academy of Sculpture Art four times. He has also been honored by the National Sculpture Society and the National Academy of Design.
