Dental Care Survey Results Checks Saturday at East Hills

Among the results of a survey of family toothbrushing practices conducted with the cooperation of the Bureau of Dental Health Education, five years ago were these: Nearly 60 percent of each household used only one toothbrush. About half of all respondents used a toothbrush four to six times a day. The survey and medical personnel of the St. Joseph dental center will perform a dental check-up on Saturday.
